Guidance for Vaccinated Employees

These guidelines apply to outpatient and academic settings

only. This does NOT apply to the inpatient setting. Masks are recommended for those who are vaccinated and have unvaccinated or immune-compromised members of their household. Vaccination status must be clearly identified on your employee badge. Universal masking for patients and visitors remains in effect.
