

Opportunities to Pay for Medical Education in West Virginia for Medical Students, Residents, and Physicians

Option 1: Practice obligations can be served *concurrently*. Amounts can total from \$70,000 to \$160,000.

OPTION 2: The State Loan Repayment Program, which is state and federally funded, is state administered. Recipient must not be under any other service obligation. Amount can total up to \$90,000.

OPTION 3: The NHSC Loan Repayment Program is federally funded and administered. Recipient must not be under any other service obligation. With continued service, NHSC providers may be able to pay off all of their student loans.

OPTION 4: This pilot program is federally funded and administered. Recipient must not be under any other service obligation. Amount can total up to \$120,000. Additional loan repayment may be awarded yearly.
