

The Critical Care Conference is designed to educate healthcare providers regarding the diagnosis, treatment and management of sepsis, skin breakdown and pneumothorax in critical care patients and to provide a forum for interdisciplinary discussion of challenging critical care issues to include current research, best practice and clinical practice guidelines. The objectives of this conference are:

- Identify signs and symptoms of early and late sepsis.
- Compare and contrast the efficacy and limitations of procalcitonin as a diagnostic tool for sepsis.
- Summarize the criteria for a sepsis alert and create a plan of care for the patient.
- Create a plan of care for a specific patient with critical care needs including sepsis.
- Differentiate the symptoms of pneumothorax from other pulmonary complications.
- Formulate a plan of care to decrease skin breakdown in the critically ill adult
