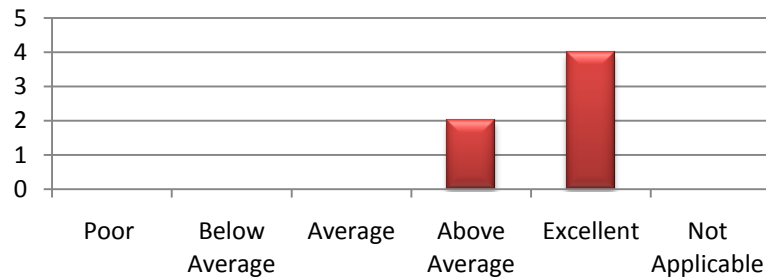

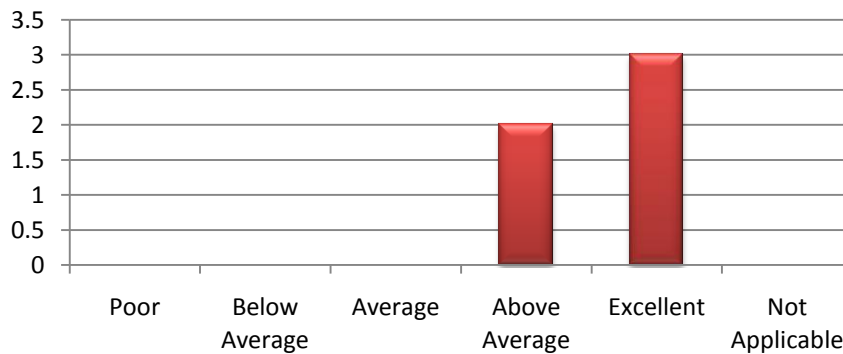
**Rating of Overall Session**

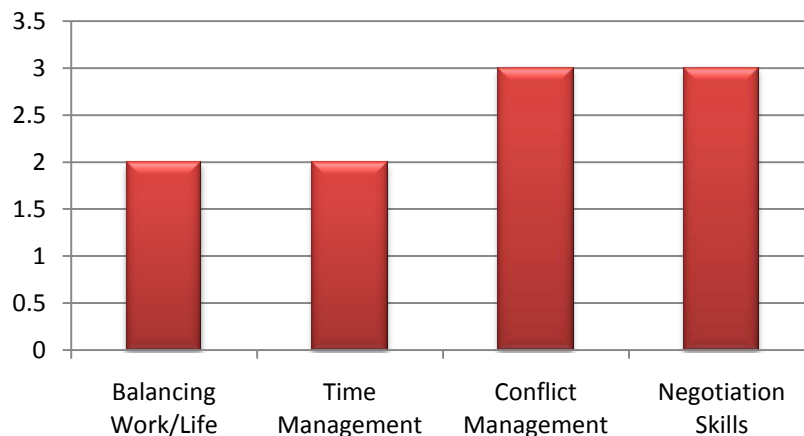
