

**CME Faculty Selection Criteria-CME Policy 2001, revised 2005.**

- A. Purpose. To provide a standard for selection of faculty for all Continuing Medical Education sponsored activities.
- B. Policy. Faculty will be chosen based on the specifically determined criteria that will fulfill the educational needs of the target audience.
- C. General Provisions. The potential faculty will meet the following criteria:
  - a. Expertise in specific subject area.
  - b. Knowledge of practice issues and problems related to subject matter.
  - c. Respected by medical staff and held in high regard by the medical community at large.
  - d. Expertise in teaching methods and learning strategies.
  - e. Knowledge of adult learning process.
  - f. Willingness to follow criteria for CME as set forth by the planning committee.
  - g. Willingness to Disclose relationships with industry that would Conflict with the presentation of the topic.
  - h. Ability to address learning needs of the target audience.
  - i. Affordability and follows the CME Honorarium Policy.
