

Adopt a Medical Student

Thousands of students apply annually to the Marshall University Joan C. Edwards School of Medicine with the dream of becoming a physician. For them and many prospective students, the skyrocketing cost of attending medical school, coupled with the prospect of six-figure debt, can make that dream seem almost unattainable.

At Marshall, more than 90 percent of medical students rely on federal student loans to supplement their finances, making scholarships more important than ever.

Adopting a medical student is about more than financial support. It's about the lasting relationship that develops between you and your student.

How It Works

Adopt a Medical Student makes it possible to provide immediate financial support for a student while establishing an endowed fund that will make a lasting impact.

The concept is simple. With just a four-year commitment of \$19,000, you can create a \$15,000 endowed scholarship while supporting a medical student with a \$4,000 scholarship over those four years.

Future Years ... Annual gift of your choice

It takes four years for your \$15,000 endowment investment to accrue interest to generate an annual scholarship. At the end of Year 4, you can continue adding to your investment with a gift of your choice. The larger the endowment, the greater the scholarship awarded to a student.
