What are ACE points?

The Office for Faculty Advancement will reward and recognize ALL JCESOM Faculty and Resident, who exhibit outstanding citizenship with “Academic Citizenship Excellence” points.

What do I need to do to receive ACE points?

Participate in volunteer-based professional enhancement activities offered throughout the year.

How many ACE points will be given per year?

At least 50 ACE points will be awarded per year.

How many ACE points will be given per activity?

Activities lasting 30-45 minutes (web-based or onsite) will equal 5 ACE points.
