Fellows can also work with the Program Director to develop personalized elective experiences tailored to their interests.

Electives are typically taken in 1-month blocks. Fellows can devote more than one month to a particular elective.

Fellows can participate in the Academic Psychiatry track. 5% of time can be protected in F1 and during 6 month residential rotation of F2.

For those interested in Interventional Psychiatry, M and W from 8-9am will be blocked for ECT. Thursday afternoons from 3-5pm for rTMS mapping.

Advanced psychotherapy can be used to pursue certification or additional training in a psychotherapy modality, eg. TF-CBT, play therapy, etc.

Clinic schedule notes:

General and Developmental Clinics:

- For the first two months intakes will be 120 min and follow-ups 30 min. Beginning in Sept, intakes will be reduced to 90 min to better conform to a typical attending format. Intakes on Monday morning are scheduled at 10am and on Wednesday afternoons at 3pm.
