Electives are typically taken in 1-month blocks. Fellows can devote more than one month to a particular elective.

Fellows can participate in the Academic Psychiatry track. 5% of time can be protected in F1 and during 6 month residential rotation of F2.

For those interested in Interventional Psychiatry, M and W from 8-9am will be blocked for ECT. Thursday afternoons from 3-5pm for rTMS mapping.

Advanced psychotherapy can be used to pursue certification or additional training in a psychotherapy modality, eg. TF-CBT, play therapy, etc.
