FAQ

Is there any cost to participate?

Participation is free for all faculty, residents, students, and staff!

How do conversation café discussions work?

The conversation café will have a moderator (faculty/resident/student/staff) who manages the forum where discussions occur online. The moderator will pose questions to members, share relevant articles, and facilitate conversation about topics in the book. Members will be encouraged to post and share as well. This format allows for ongoing conversation and makes it easy for readers to connect with each other through the forum.

Will there be any in-person meetings of the conversation café?

No. We will meet in a virtual setting using Microsoft TEAMS to discuss the book or podcast at a prearranged date and time. We will post the link for you to join.

What is the time commitment and what are the expectations? Do I need to read every book? There is no formal time commitment for the conversation café; you can spend as much or as little time participating as you'd like. We will provide as much supplemental material as possible for each conversation so everyone is able to participate, even if you don't have time to read the book cover to cover. The books selected will relate to lifelong learning, personal growth, and other relevant topics.
