ABOUT PROJECT DOCC

The Marshall University Joan C. Edwards School of Medicine prepares its trainees to better serve the needs of children with chronic illnesses and disabilities. Through its Parent Partners in Education Project (PPIE), parents serve as teachers known as "family faculty." In this role, they emphasize family-centered care specific to families of children with special health care needs.

The innovative training, adapted from the national curriculum known as Project DOCC (Delivery of Chronic Care), is delivered to third- and fourth-year medical students as well as second-year family medicine and pediatric residents. PPIE is sponsored by the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources Office of Maternal, Child and Family Health and the departments of pediatrics and family medicine at the Joan C. Edwards School of Medicine and Marshall Health.
