

# Financial Aid Tasks and Timelines

## FINANCIAL AID REQUIREMENTS

- Check your myMU account for any additional financial aid requirements and submit as soon as possible (preferable before May 1).
- Notification of your financial aid award will be sent late March to early April. This will include any renewable scholarships.
- Check your account at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov) to see your current borrowing.

## GET READY FOR YOUR NEXT YEAR

- Bills for the semester are sent by the Bursar's Office in July and are due in August.
- If you are a first time loan borrower (Federal Direct and PLUS), you must complete Loan Entrance Counseling and a Master Promissory Note.
- Financial Aid refunds are disbursed during the first week of class.

## 2023-2024 FAFSA IS AVAILABLE

- Submit your FAFSA no later than April 15.
- Marshall University school code is 003815.
- FAFSA is required to be considered for institutional scholarships.
- Parental information is not required.
