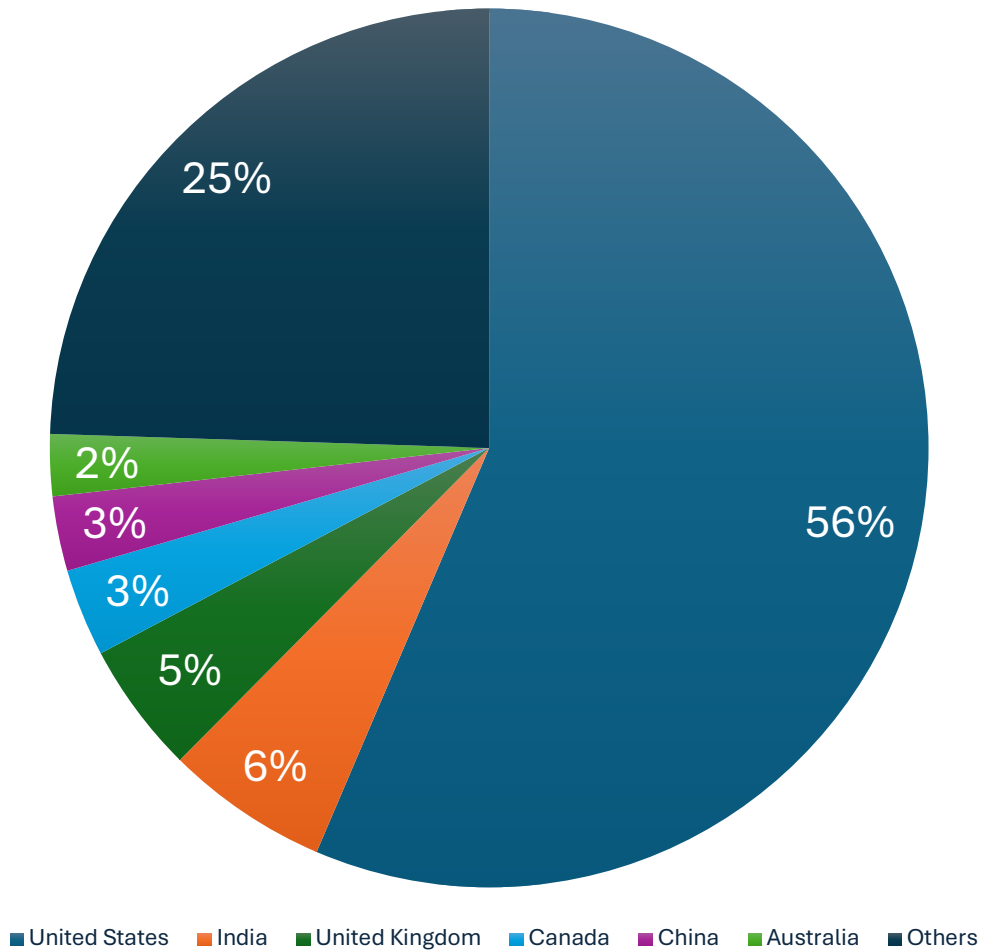

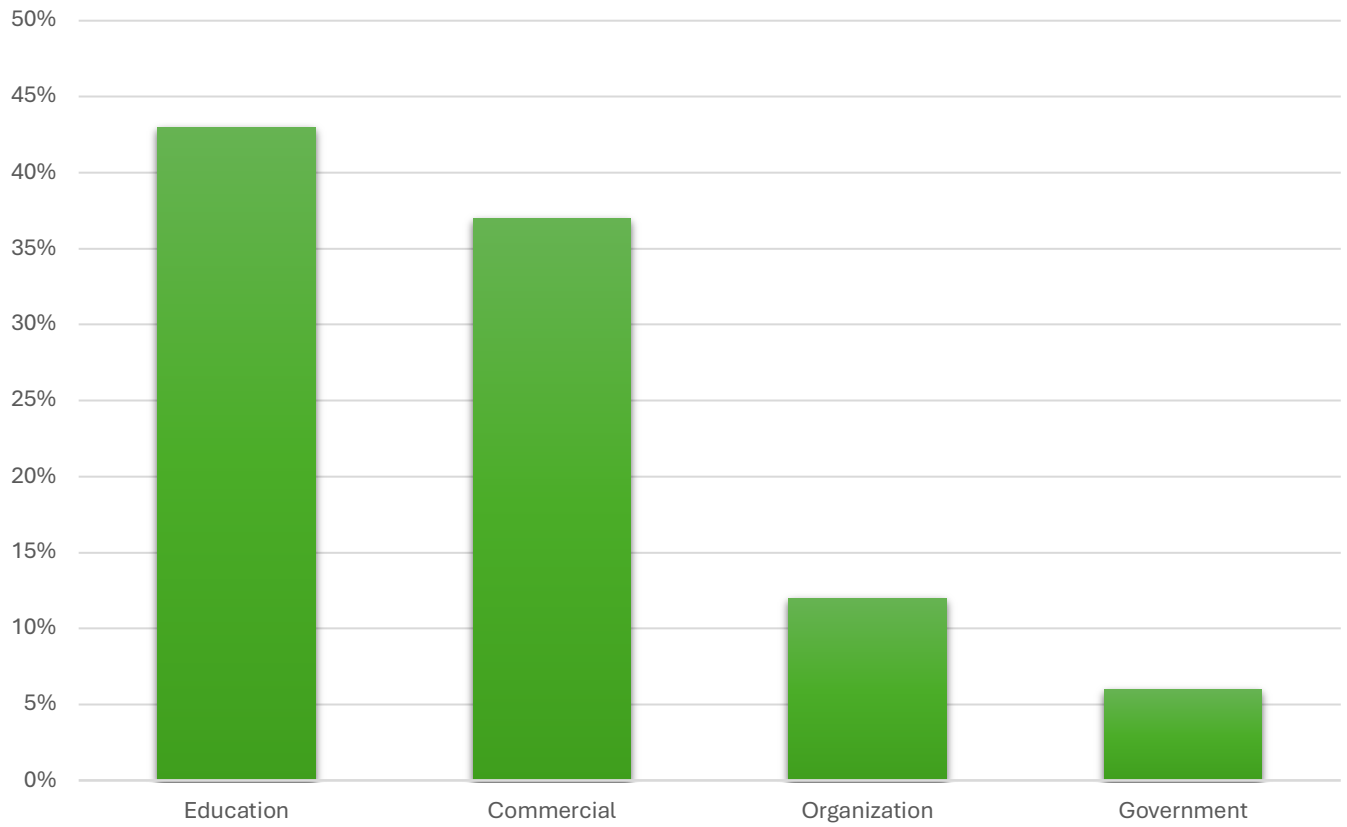

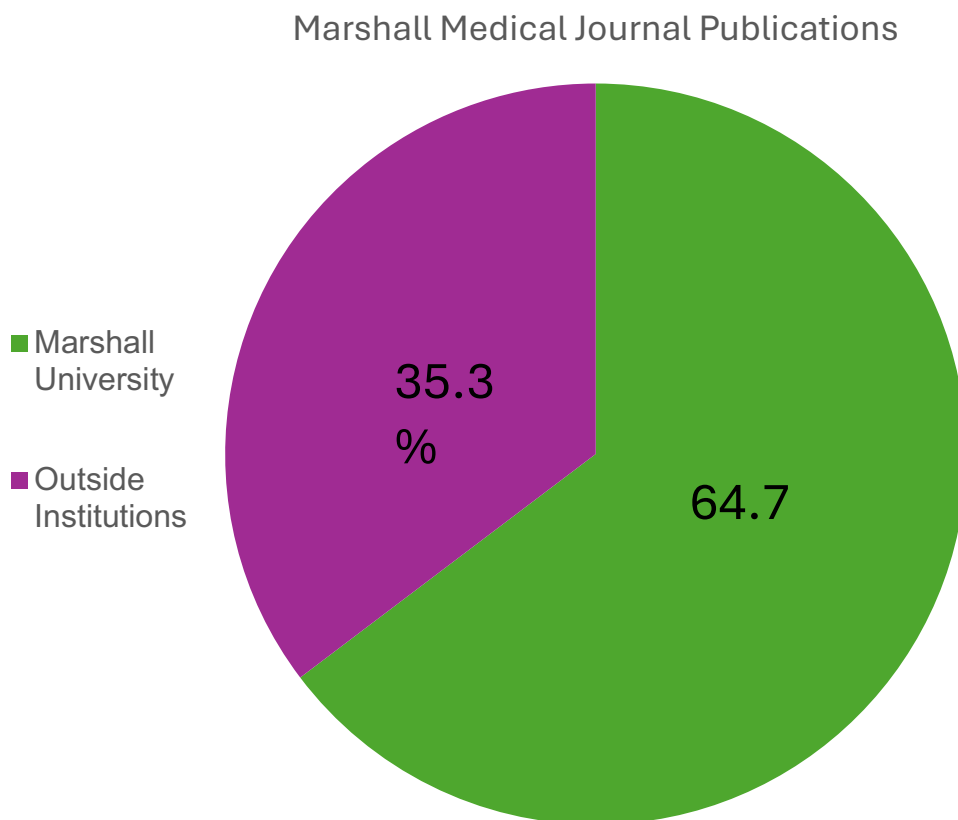

The score is based on relevant mentions from social media sites, newspapers, policy documents, blogs, Wikipedia, and many other sources.

PlumX captures a comprehensive set of research metrics in five categories, each represented by a color

- Usage (green)
- Captures (purple)
- Mentions (yellow)
- Social media (blue)
- Citations (orange)

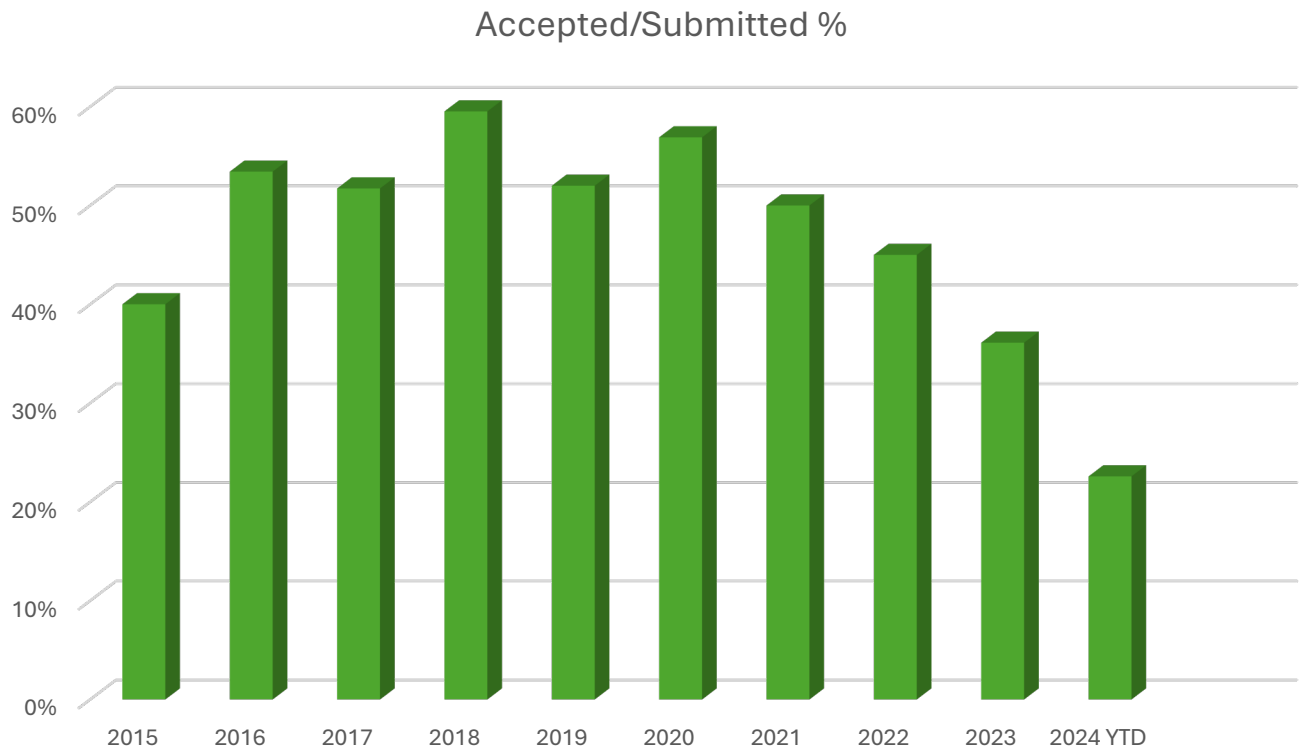
