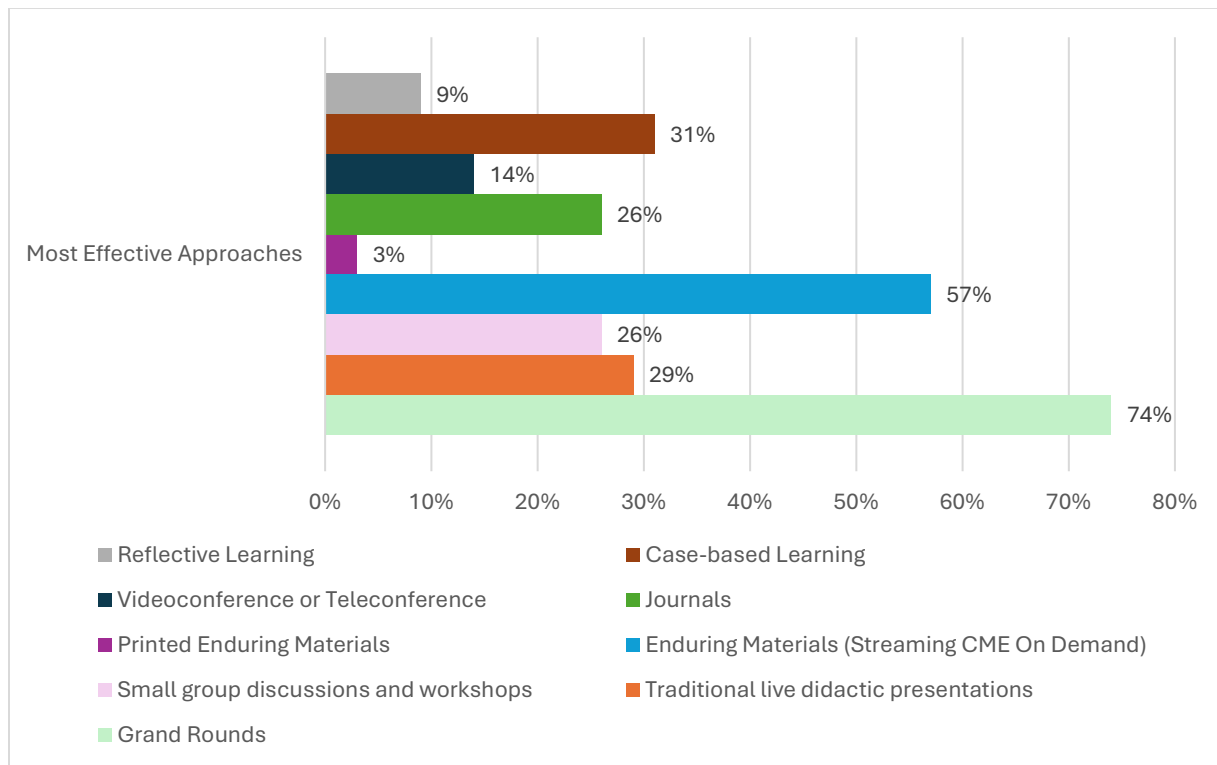

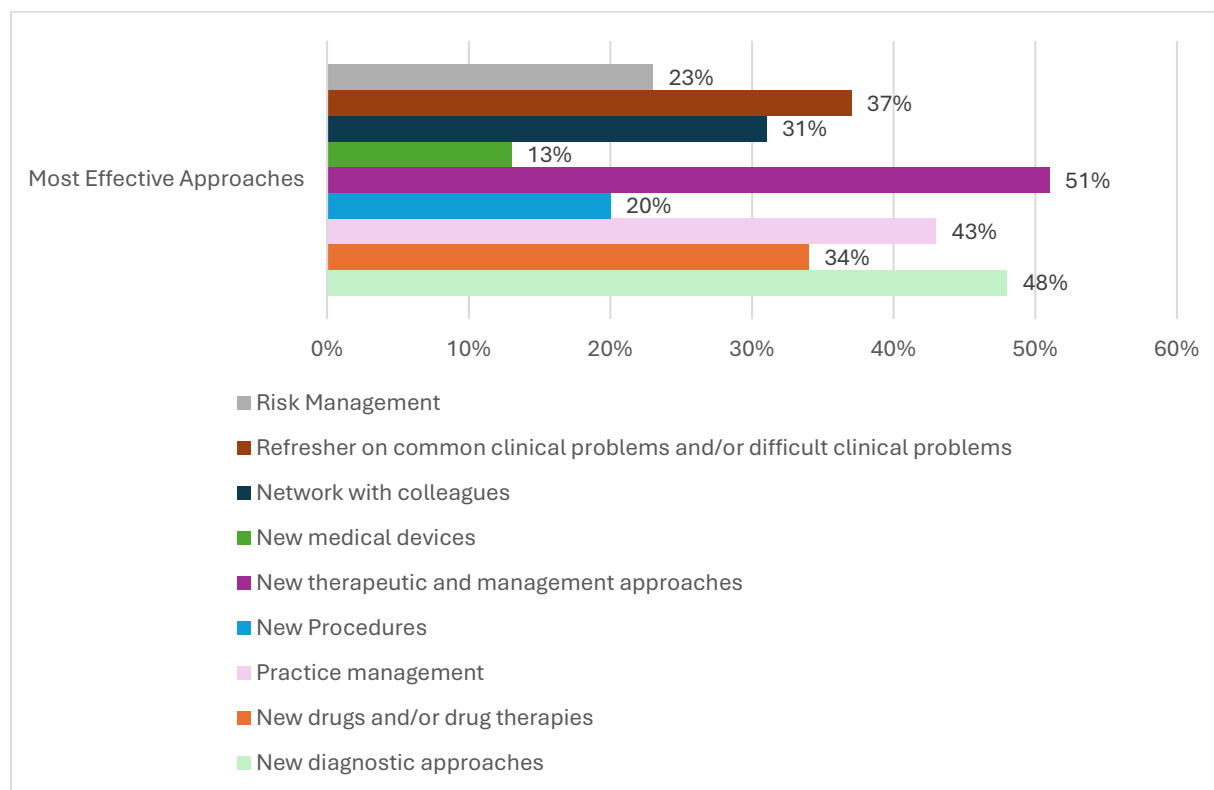
**Which of the following approaches do you find most effective in acquiring new knowledge that can be applied in your practice?**
